


Andreas Diaz Andersson's minimalist abstractions, created using cotton thread on canvas, are defined as much by his harmonious use of lines and colour as by the negative space on the canvas. ENTRE, meaning between in Spanish, explores this notion to its fullest extent. Made with exceptional precision and a meticulous attention to detail, his works are an exploration of depth and form, hovering between illusion and abstraction. The spaces left between each thread allow the composition to take shape with a spatially reflective quality. A constant variation of dynamic geometric patterns and deep vanishing points play with perception, fluctuating as the viewer sees the work from different angles.


Diaz Andersson in a sense is between two worlds himself. The influence of his upbringing first in Sweden and then Mexico is evident in his work. Scandinavian order and organisation define his technique. The colours and textures evoque a Mexican sense of warmth and materiality. Both countries have a strong tradition of textile art, but it is a synthesis between two very different cultures that Diaz Andersson so successfully expresses in his works, creating paintings that are both unique and universal.



Cotton thread and acrylic on canvas









#### Entre II

Cotton thread and acrylic on canvas









Cotton thread and acrylic on canvas









