We are pleased to announce our upcoming exhibition 'Chroma Cut' by Tycjan Knut which opens in London on 21 November. Having represented Knut since 2019, this will be the artist's second solo exhibition with Cadogan.

The artworks in the show employ gradients to simulate light direction or imitate reflective structures, producing a perception of depth. The colour field figures are carved into sharp geometric forms, at times incorporating optical illusions that allude to the presence of shadows.

The exhibition is fundamentally about the relationship between gradients and structures with their background. The incisions into the primary colour fields integrate the background into the composition of the painting, echoing principles of spatialism.

The artist has more recently ventured into experimentation with blue pigments, adding an additional layer of complexity to the compositions in this exhibition.
